NARRATIVE - S. SQUIRES

Offender: Stephen Douglas Baker

Offenses: Obstruction of Officers- Felony (16-10-24.b) x2; Simple Battery on Police (16-5-23.e) x2

On Wednesday (12-13-2017) at approximately 1320 hrs Deputy T. Ingram #828 and myself responded to Isolation cell ten which is a padded cell after being called via radio by Deputy W. Payne #832 that Inmate Stephen Douglas Baker was covering his camera in the cell. Due to his recent attempts of self-harm, the decision was made to enter the cell and remove the items covering the camera and any items in the cell that could potentially be used to cover it.

Upon arrival we advised Baker to go to the back of the cell and face the wall until we could get the items out. While standing at the entrance to the cell he refused our request twice and kept asking where Payne was, that he was gonna whoop his ass. I advised Baker to step out of the cell and face the wall opposite to the cell, which he did. I then entered the cell and removed paper towels and toilet paper from the camera and the cell floor. While exiting the cell I overheard Baker stating that he would whoop our asses as he turned from the wall toward Ingram. Deputy Ingram gave several loud verbal commands to face the wall and not to turn around. I placed my hands onto his back to secure him to the wall due to his refusal to follow orders. He then pushed off the wall into me at which time I wrapped my arms around him in efforts to stop his resistance. At this time a call was issued via radio of officers involved in a fight. He continued to physically resist by attempting to free himself from my hold and struck me with his elbow in my right torso area. I then struck him with a closed fist strike to the head to deter the violence. He then continued to physically resist and struck me in the right side of my face with his arm. I followed once more with closed fist strikes to the head to again try to deter the violence. Continuing to resist and pull away, I wrapped my arms around him and pinned him against the wall and he kicked me in the shin. Deputy W. Barkley arrived to assist in gaining control of Baker who was continuing to offer violence. As other officers arrived to assist, I pulled Baker back and assisted him to the floor, securing him while other officers handcuffed him. We then lifted him to his feet and placed him back into ISO cell ten. Once in the cell he refused to go to his stomach in order to uncuff him, resulting in him being escorted to the padded cell floor. He was then given loud clear instructions not to get up or cause further incident. He was uncuffed and all officers exited the cell.

*****. Due to the incident, I secured warrants for felony obstruction x2 and simple battery against a police officer x2 against Baker.

Nothing further
